



Kaurilands Home Learning Guidelines - Year 1 - 3

From Monday 23rd August Kaurilands will be reinstating our online distance learning programme for our children.

Below you will find a detailed guide as to what our teachers will be providing as part of our Home Learning/ Distance Learning programme here at Kaurilands. We acknowledge that everyone's circumstances are different with many families juggling work, school and family. Your first priority is the wellbeing of your families. Be kind to yourselves. If you need any help or further clarification with anything, please get in touch with your child's teacher via email. We are here to help!

Time of learning

- **Teachers will be in touch by 4:00pm via Hero (email) with learning tasks for the following day.**
- **Teachers will be available to respond to communication from 9:00am - 3.00pm. If you have any questions or need any help please email your child's teacher.**

Seesaw

- **Children can access seesaw using their home logins/codes from last time. If you need a new code, please email your child's teacher/s.**
- **Each week your child's teacher/s will assign a variety of learning tasks for your child to work through on seesaw.**
- **Up to 2 hours of work will be shared. Your child's teacher will reference these activities in their daily communication email.**
- **Children are invited to share their learning on seesaw and teachers will comment and give feedback.**

Please note that your child will not need a device to complete these activities. They can be completed using resources around your home. Seesaw will be used to share the activities and for your children to upload their completed tasks. If you are having trouble using seesaw please contact your child's teacher.

How often

- There will be a **daily communication email** from your teacher via email (Monday - Friday beginning Sunday 22nd August). This will be sent by 4pm, providing information about the learning activities for the following day.
- The daily email will contain new **core learning** tasks each day (Literacy and Numeracy task) along with a couple of **creative based** learning tasks.
- If you would like some further assistance, clarification or to connect, parents can email their child's teacher.

Connection time

- Collaborative spaces - will use home-groups. In other words each teacher will be responsible for assigning work and staying connected with their home group.
- Teachers will schedule a Zoom meeting with the whole class (home group) every second day (Tuesday and Thursday).
Year Level times:
Year 0+1: 10:00-10:30
Year 2: 10:30-11:00
Year 3: 11:00- 11:30
It would be great if your child can make these meetings, but we understand if this is not possible. For support with this please contact your child's teacher.
Teachers are following strict protocol while using Zoom to ensure your children are kept safe.
- Your teacher may also schedule one on one or small group check ins at different times throughout the week.
- There will be a **daily communication email** from your teacher through Hero (Monday - Friday beginning Sunday 22nd August). This email will be sent by 4pm, informing you of the activities and information for the following day.

Alert Level 4 means that all schools are closed for all learners and teachers. Teachers will be working in Year Level teams to plan lessons so some activities and videos will be coming from other teachers in your child's year level team.

Time of learning

- Teachers will email all families by 4:00pm with the learning tasks and further information for the following day.
- We would encourage approximately 1.5 hours of **core learning** time per day. For example - Literacy or Numeracy tasks- creative writing, online workshops or practising basic facts etc. These tasks will be assigned daily by a teacher with clear guidelines.
- We would encourage approximately 1.5 hours of **creative project based** learning per day. For example - working on a passion project etc. These tasks will be assigned weekly by a teacher with clear guidelines.

Seesaw

- Children can access seesaw using their home logins from last time. If you need a new code, please email your child's teacher/s.
- Each week your child's teacher/s will assign some Numeracy and Literacy activities for them to complete during their core learning time. Your child's teacher will reference these activities in their daily communication email.
- We encourage children to post to Seesaw to share what they have been working on. They can also send us a video message if they would like to connect with us as their teachers.

Please note that your child will not need a device to complete these activities. They can be completed using resources around your home. Seesaw will be used to share the activities and for your children to upload their completed tasks. If you are having trouble using seesaw please contact your child's teacher/s.

How often

- There will be a **daily communication email** from your child's teacher via email (Monday - Friday beginning Sunday 22nd August). This will be sent by 4pm informing you of the activities and information for the following day.

- The daily email will contain new **core learning** tasks to be worked through the following day along with a couple of **creative project based** learning tasks that will last for a week or two.

Connection time

- Collaborative spaces - will use home-groups. In other words each teacher will be responsible for assigning work and staying connected with their home group whānau.
- Teachers will schedule a Zoom meeting with the whole class (home group) every second day (Tuesday and Thursday).
Year 4: 11:30- 12:00
Year 5: 12:00-12:30
Year 6: 12:30-1:00
- It would be great if your child can make these meetings, but we understand if this is not possible. For support with this please contact your child's teacher.
